Course Description This three day workshop taught by Gail Ritchie, OTR, C/NDT, Pediatric NDTA OT Instructor is designed for therapists working with infants from birth to three years of age who have known or suspected Neuro-motor disorders such as Cerebral Palsy. A major emphasis will be placed on handling techniques and treatment strategies. Current motor control research, assessment and treatment principles from and NDT problem solving perspective, typical and atypical motor development for postural control, GM, UE and respiration, the developing sensory systems of infants and parent/caregiver home program are all covered in this course. This course is lab intensive with a heavy emphasis on handling techniques and treatment strategies presented through labs and demonstrations.

Learning Objectives: At the conclusion of this course participants will be able to:

- 1) Detail 15 significant aspects of typical/atypical motor control development within the first year.
- 2) Develop home program considerations to include 5 activities to support caregivers during this acute phase to their adjustment of caring for child with developmental issues.
- 3) Explain 6 multiple dynamic system interactions in typical/atypical motor control.
- 4) Discuss process for assessment of infants with neuromuscular and sensorimotor involvement.
- 5) Articulate 10 treatment strategies learned during lab practicum to translate into your own daily practice of infants/young children.
